## Spelling rules

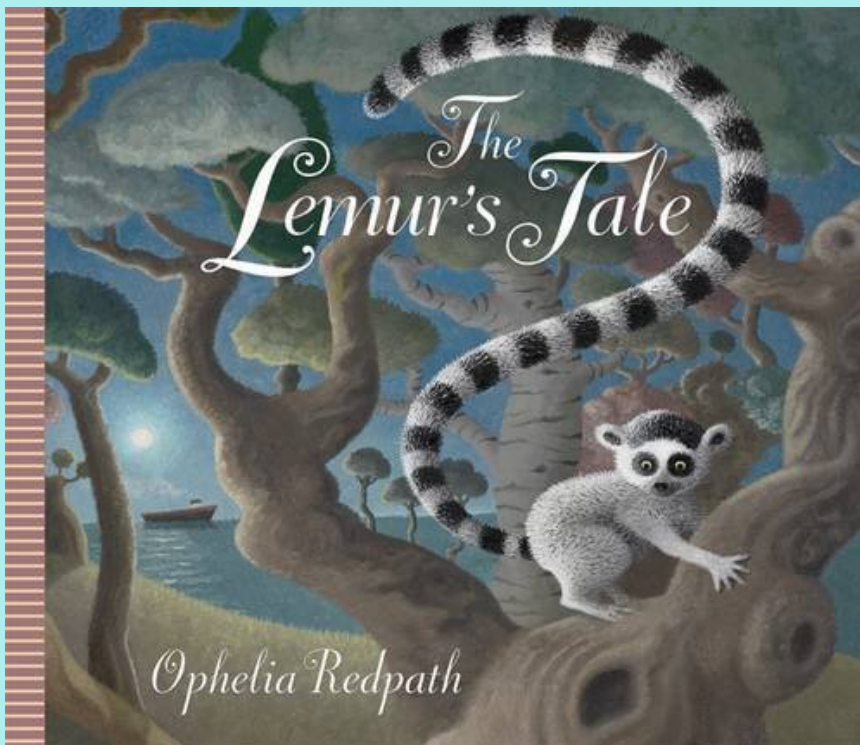
Change the y to i  
before adding ful, ness,  
ly

beauty  
happy  
angry  
lonely  
empty  
hungry

Keep the 'e' before  
-ment, ful, ly

achieve	care
excite	peace
argue	hope
replace	waste
involve	like
